The Lake County YMCA 2010 Dream House is located at 1500 Villa Grande Drive in Villa Grande at Lake Erie Shores. The 3,400 square foot Cape Cod style home features uniquely designed rooms and numerous windows allowing for panoramic views of Lake Erie from nearly every room.

- This home’s open and inviting main floor begins with the incredible Lake View Den. The Living Room has custom built-in bookcases that create a special library feel. It’s a great place to curl up and read or to have a quiet chat with a friend. And when the holidays come, this space flows into the Dining Room to make a welcoming place to celebrate with family and friends. The Great Room in the Hearth Area features soaring ceilings, large windows, and a two-sided fireplace that opens into the Kitchen. The light and airy eat-in Kitchen showcases state-of-the-art Jenn-Air appliances and Cambria natural quartz countertops and opens onto the back patio.
- A Butler’s Pantry and Powder Room are also located on main floor.
- Located on the second floor, the tranquil Master Suite has a private wrap around deck for summer star-gazing and is attached to an elegant Master Bathroom with original mirrors and Cambria natural quartz bathtub deck, shower walls and countertops. It also features a large walk-in custom Master Closet.
- A Guest Room and Guest Bath await on the second floor. These rooms blend new and traditional furnishings to hold true to the design scheme. As an added touch of Western Reserve history, a historic fireplace mantel from master builder Jonathan Goldsmith (1819-34) has been transformed into the headboard.
- The second floor also features Jack and Jill Bedrooms with a shared Bathroom. The mix of new and cherished pieces give these rooms a playful charm perfect for new memories to be made at the Water’s Edge.
- A time-saving Laundry Room is conveniently located on the second floor.
- The unique third floor Crow’s Nest provides a sanctuary with original artwork and dramatic natural lighting; this room captures the breathtaking views of the Fairport Harbor lighthouse and Lake Erie sunsets.
- The lower level creates “a cool place to be” for kids. A perfect area to hang out, relax, watch TV, play video games, and party with the family or a group of friends. The lower level also includes a Powder Room.
- Exclusive amenities for the Dream House and Lake Erie Shores residents include a private beach, gazebo and picnic area.
